Author names must be typed in 10 point Times New Roman, and should be centered on the page. First name is first, followed by the second name or family name. The name of the presenting author is underline, and the name(s) of corresponding author(s) is indicated by an asterisk. Example:

Patchreenart Saparpakorn^{1,2} Supa Hannongbua^{1,2}*

Leave a line then type affiliations with size10, italic and centered on the page. Example:

Leave a line then type the text, single spaced in 11 point Times New Roman, full justification. Do not use sub headings, do not indent paragraphs, single space between paragraphs.

Abstracts are to be a maximum of 300 words.

Abstract information must not appear on or outside the margins. To prepare it, please use the template. The abstract should not exceed one page.

Formatted to A4 21cm x 29.7cm (8.27" x 11.69") with the following margin settings:

Top & Bottom & Right - 2.54 cm (1")

Left - 3.00 cm (1.18 ")

Note: You should use "paste, special, unformatted text" to prevent pasting of foreign formats into the document.

Leave a line then type the text, single spaced in 11 point Times New Roman.
