



Declaration of Intent on No Gift Policy

Fiscal Year 2025

Preventing and suppressing corruption is one of the important policies of the Thailand government, and it is considered as an urgent agenda of the country. Defined in the 20-year National Strategy (2019-2039) which is conducive to the Thirteenth National Economic and Social Development Plan (2023-2027), the No Give Policy stipulates the management of the government sectors free from corruption which, in turn, promotes good governance in the Thai society.

Accordingly, all administrators and personnel of the Demonstration School, University of Phayao, deem it important to strictly comply to the No Gift Policy set by the Thailand government. To prevent and combat against all forms of corruption and to promote organizational transparency and integrity, all are to abide by the following measures:

1. Never request or accept gifts or benefit from performing duties.
2. Adhere to the university's ethical standards with good attitude and clear conscience.
